4. To be eligible you **must** compete at the **OQHA Spring Show and Redbud Spectacular**. The other shows are optional, but participation will count toward your overall total.
5. In Non-Pro, if a horse/rider participates in Level 1 and standard Youth or Amateur class, points from both classes will count.
6. If a horse (Open) or horse/rider (Youth or Amateur) shows at Halter, those points will also count, however Halter is not a requirement.
7. No additional entry fee is required. Participation within your classes will automatically enter you in the Series.
8. Points will be kept and tabulated by OQHA
9. Awards will be presented after results are tabulated from the Redbud Spectacular.
